Volunteer Opportunities

There are three ways to volunteer for Beverly Main Streets and make downtown a great place to live, work, invest and experience!

We have standing <u>committees</u> which meet monthly and oversee a wide variety of initiatives. Most volunteers make a long-term commitment (1 year or more) so they can see the work through to completion. The committees require a combination of people who have expertise in the area and people who have an interest but might not consider themselves experts in the area.

We have several <u>task forces</u> that focus on very specific projects. They usually last from 3-6 months with meetings once or twice a month and research / activities in between meetings. We look for people who have expertise with the topic to be on the task forces.

We host several <u>major events</u> throughout the year that require two types of volunteers: those who can help plan and manage the event and those who can volunteer on the day of the event. We look for volunteers who can dive into the details and follow-through on making connections. Event committees typically meet once a month until a month before the event when they start to meet weekly. There are often work assignments to be done in between the meetings. On the day of the event, we need volunteers who can be on hand for the entire event.
